Birth of a Family is not a programmatic approach. It is a relational approach designed for single men and single women, cohabiting and married couples.



Typically, Birth of a Family is presented as a weekly group activity where facilitators initiate discussion around the subjects offered in the discussion guide segments.

Resources are also provided in the Toolbox but many facilitators use additional resources as well. The goal is to offer group experiences that provide participants with opportunities to experience self-initiated changes in heart-level beliefs in a nonthreatening atmosphere rich with mentoring and support.

MISSION & VALUES

1. Relaxed & Welcoming.

Participants often arrive expecting a programmatic approach but are surprised & encouraged by the low-key atmosphere.

2. Relevant.

Discussion guides help direct conversations to topics that are relevant to the deeper issues participants face.

3. Respectful & Flexible.

Facilitators are trained to be responsive to the direction participants take the conversation while still promoting the key objectives outlined in the discussion guides.

3. Supportive.

Family Coaches are trained volunteers that participate in discussion right alongside participants. Their mentoring & support is key to making self-initiated heart level change occur in participants.
